

NAME

`sjisconv` – convert a TeX document in SJIS encoding into ‘preprocessed’ form.

SYNOPSIS

`sjisconv <infile> <outfile>`

DESCRIPTION

SJIS encoding for Japanese uses the characters {, }, and \ which have special meanings in \TeX documents.

After processing a $\text{\LaTeX} 2_{\epsilon}$ document which contains SJIS characters with `sjisconv` you need not care about these special characters.

This filter is part of the **CJK** macro package for $\text{\LaTeX} 2_{\epsilon}$.
